Clear for Take-Off at Centennial Airport

XJet is Granted Full FBO Approval by the Centennial Airport Authority and Board of Directors

Denver, CO., February 2007 – XJet, a new concept in Business Aviation support, has recently been granted the approval to become a full service FBO at Centennial Airport by the Centennial Airport Authority and its Full Board of Directors. Centennial is one of the nation's largest general aviation airports.

The facility is currently under construction and will open its doors to Program Participants in July 2007. The facility will be built in III phases. When complete, the unique FBO campus will comprise of over 18 acres of land, over 110,000 square feet of hangar and executive office space, over 5,800 square feet of Indoor vehicle parking, and 7,000 square feet of area for the 5 star restaurant and catering facilities.

Denver based Klipp was the chosen architect for the project for their innovative design and their history of extensive award winning projects in Denver. Shaw Construction was hired as the primary construction contractor.
